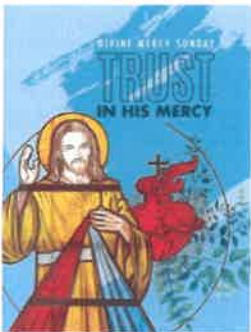
COME AND JOIN —The Social Committee invites all adult parishioners, and their guests, to the O'Bryan Center on Tuesday, April 2, for game night!

FROM FR. CARLOS:

“Speak, Mary, declaring
What you saw, wayfaring.
"The tomb of Christ, who is
living,
The glory of Jesus' resurrec-
tion”
Sequence Easter Sunday

“What we have seen and heard, is what we testified.”
Paul, Peter and John and all the disciples manifested this statement to both the Jewish and the gentiles about Jesus's Resurrection. From now on God is God for all and not just for Jewish.

And that declaration is what makes our faith today alive and truly authentic and unique. The Resurrection of Jesus is the starting but also the turning point in the faith of the disciple. What makes us truly Jesus's Disciples is not just his miracles and his healing power in our lives, not either his powerful words and deeds but the fact He is indeed alive. He has risen for all, to save all.

The resurrection unites all the human race in one Man and God Jesus Christ, who carries in his cross the death of any human evil and also lifts up and rises with Him the fallen human nature overwhelmed by sin.

During this season we will hear Peter proclaiming in the liturgy fairly exploded with his good news: "It's God's own truth, nothing could be plainer: God plays no favorites! It makes no difference who you are or where you're from-if you want God and are ready to do as he says, the door is open. The Message he sent to the children of Israel— that through Jesus Christ everything is being put together again-well, he's doing it everywhere, among everyone. (Acts 10: 34-43)

Dear family and friends of Saint Mildred and Good Shepherd we are all proud of our faith and love for God and what is bringing us in His resurrection, let us kindle and extend the joy and peace during this Easter season, let us bind our bonds of unity and friendship that every heart, every Christian present here in our churches proclaims that Jesus is alive.
