From our parishioner Billy Sims:

In John's Gospel, Jesus assures us, "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me". This beautiful image speaks directly to our lives today. Amidst the clamor of daily life, filled with countless voices and distractions, how do we recognize and heed the voice of our Shepherd?

Just as sheep trust their shepherd, we are called to cultivate a deep trust in Jesus. This means spending time in prayer, listening for His guidance in Scripture, and recognizing His presence in the sacraments. When we face decisions, big or small, we can ask ourselves: does this align with the love, compassion, and justice Jesus taught?

Following Him isn't always easy; it requires courage and a willingness to step away from the crowd. Yet, Jesus promises, "I give them eternal life, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand." Let us strive each day to listen attentively to His voice, allowing His love to guide our steps and bring us closer to the security of His embrace. By intentionally seeking His presence in prayer and reflecting on His teachings, we deepen our personal connection and find security in His love amidst life's uncertainties.

Seguirlo no siempre es fácil; Requiere coraje y voluntad de alejarse de la multitud. Sin embargo, Jesús promete: "Yo les doy la vida eterna, y no perecerán jamás, y nadie los arrebatará de mi mano". Esforcémonos cada día por escuchar atentamente su voz, dejando que su amor guíe nuestros pasos y nos acerque a la seguridad de su abrazo. Al buscar intencionalmente Su presencia en oración y reflexionar sobre Sus enseñanzas, profundizamos nuestra

conexión personal y encontramos seguridad en Su amor en medio de las incertidumbres de la vida.
