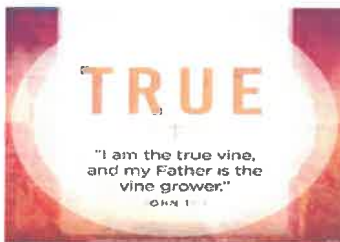
We are Easter people! Let us rejoice! O sing a new song to the Lord for He has worked wonders...(Psalm 98)

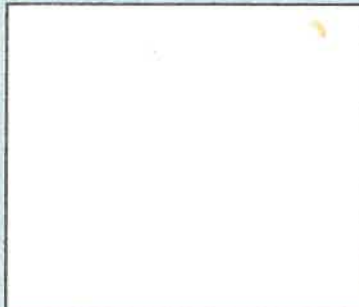
