ARTICLE BY BILLY SIMS:

On this first Sunday of Lent, this week's Gospel, Luke 4:1-13, recounts Jesus's 40 days of temptation in the wilderness.

Just as Jesus faced trials of hunger, worldly power, and doubting God, we too encounter our own "wilderness" moments. These temptations aren't always dramatic; they might be the lure of instant gratification through technology (especially social media!), the pressure to compromise our integrity for success, or the subtle whispers of doubt when faced with hardship.

The devil's tactics are consistent. He targets our vulnerabilities, seeking to stumble us on God's path to salvation. In our modern world, the constant barrage of information and the emphasis on material possessions can easily distract us from spiritual growth. Like Jesus, we must rely on Scripture and prayer to combat these temptations. When we feel the pull towards unhealthy habits or the urge to prioritize worldly wealth and possessions over spiritual values, we can recall Jesus's steadfast reliance on God's word.

Let us arm ourselves with "The Full Armor of God" (Eph. 6:13-17), remembering that even Jesus, the Son of God, faced temptation. By staying rooted in Christ, we can navigate our own wilderness and emerge stronger in our faith.

En este primer domingo de Cuaresma, el Evangelio de esta semana, Lucas 4:1-13, relata los 40 días de tentación de Jesús en el desierto. Así como Jesús enfrentó pruebas de hambre, poder mundano y dudar de Dios, nosotros también nos enfrentamos a nuestros propios momentos "salvajes". Estas tentaciones no siempre son dramáticas; Pueden ser el señuelo de la gratificación instantánea a través de la tecnología (¡especialmente las redes sociales!), la presión de comprometer nuestra integridad por el éxito o los sutiles susurros de duda cuando nos enfrentamos a dificultades.

Las tácticas del diablo son consistentes. Se enfoca en nuestras vulnerabilidades, tratando de hacernos tropezar en el camino de Dios hacia la salvación. En nuestro mundo moderno, el bombardeo constante de información y el énfasis en las posesiones materiales pueden distraernos fácilmente del crecimiento espiritual. Al igual que Jesús, debemos confiar en las Escrituras y en la oración para combatir estas tentaciones. Cuando sentimos la atracción hacia hábitos poco saludables o el impulso de priorizar la riqueza y las posesiones mundanas sobre los valores

espirituales, podemos recordar la firme confianza de Jesús en la palabra de Dios.

Armémonos con "toda la armadura de Dios" (Efesios 6:13-17), recordando que incluso Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, enfrentó la tentación. Al permanecer arraigados en Cristo, podemos navegar por nuestro propio desierto y emerger más fuertes en nuestra fe. -Billy
