FROM KAREN ROWE:

In today's gospel, we encounter the healing of the blind man, Bartimaeus. If he was not a believer in Jesus before this encounter, he became one at some point. Jesus remarks that "your faith has made you well" (v. 52). This pronouncement refers to the physical healing and the forgiveness of sins and everlasting life, which Bartimaeus receives through faith.

According to St. Bede, Bartimaeus signifies the Gentile nations saved by Christ. Jesus calls them to leave their spiritual blindness and sinful habits and follow Him to glory. As we reflect on the Gospel, ask yourself if you feel lost, alone, fearful, or consumed with grief. Are you sitting on the roadside as Bartimaeus did? Call out to Jesus and ask Him to be in every aspect of your life. Remember always the love that our Lord has for us, and He died for us. There is no greater Love!

En el evangelio de hoy nos encontramos con la curación del ciego Bartimeo. Si no era creyente en Jesús antes de este encuentro, en algún momento lo fue. Jesús comenta que "tu fe os ha sanado" (v. 52). Este pronunciamiento se refiere a la curación física y al perdón de los pecados y a la vida eterna, que Bartimeo recibe a través de la fe.

Según San Beda, Bartimeo significa las naciones gentiles salvadas por Cristo. Jesús los llama a dejar su ceguera espiritual y sus hábitos pecaminosos y seguirlo a la gloria. Mientras reflexionamos sobre el Evangelio, pregúntate si te sientes perdido, solo, temeroso o consumido por el dolor. ¿Estás sentado al borde del camino como lo hizo Bartimeo? Llama a Jesús y pídele que esté en cada aspecto de tu vida. Recuerden siempre el amor que nuestro Señor tiene por nosotros y murió por nosotros. ¡No hay mayor Amor!
