FROM BILLY SIMS:

This Palm Sunday, we are invited to reflect on the powerful readings that remind us of Jesus's journey to the cross, beginning with His triumphant entry into Jerusalem.

As we wave our palms today, we recall the crowds shouting "Hosanna," laying their cloaks before Him, and honoring Him as the King of Israel. Yet, this celebration contrasts sharply with what is to come—the Passion of Christ, which we will reflect on throughout Holy Week.

In the Gospel reading, we encounter the stark contrast between Jesus's entry into Jerusalem and His suffering on the cross. He enters as a King, humble and peaceful, yet the path He walks leads to rejection, pain, and sacrifice. This reminds us that the way of Christ is not one of worldly glory but of service, sacrifice, and self-giving love.

In today's world, we often seek recognition, success, and validation. Palm Sunday challenges us to ask ourselves: How do we follow Jesus? Do we seek to honor Him only when it's easy, or are we willing to embrace the humility of the cross? The call of the cross is a call to be faithful in times of triumph and trial.

As we enter Holy Week, let us take up our palms with the awareness that true glory lies not in fame but in the humility of loving service. May we walk with Jesus in the days to come, embracing His example of self-sacrifice, humility, and ultimate hope in the resurrection.
