Let us celebrate the Feast of Christ the King On the last Sunday of each liturgical year, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King. This year it is on Novem-

ber 26th. Pope Pius XI (1925) introduced this feast to combat atheism and secularism. This solemnity reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.

As we prepare for Advent and the birth of Jesus, we know that Jesus is truly divine and fully human. God comes to us as a vulnerable baby, grows, and suffers for us and died for us. He reigns over all creation.

We are called to proclaim Jesus as Lord and King, not only in private, but publicly as well. Go and proclaim the gospel and remind ourselves and others that Jesus is the Lord of the Church and the entire universe.

Let us reflect on all the good works we did as a family and a parish and continue in our new church year which begins with Advent.

UPDATE ON COLUMBARIUM—The project to add an additional columbarium unit and expand our garden has received final approval from the bishop.

The drawing for the site was placed in the bulletin earlier this year after it was approved by both the columbarium and finance committees. *Enclosed in this bulletin is a copy of the drawing.*

We just placed the order for that unit, which will match our original one, and are looking toward next May or June for delivery.


The tree in that area has already been removed, and there will be site preparation work done in the months ahead as weather permits.

This work is being overseen and coordinated by local landscape architect Mr. John Joplin. The total budget for the project, including the \$52,365 for the new unit, is \$78,350 plus Mr. Joplin's fees. Two things worth noting are 1) that the original unit, ordered in 2008, cost just under \$20,000 - so obviously a huge increase in price, and 2) only 16 out of 72 niches remain unpurchased in that original unit.

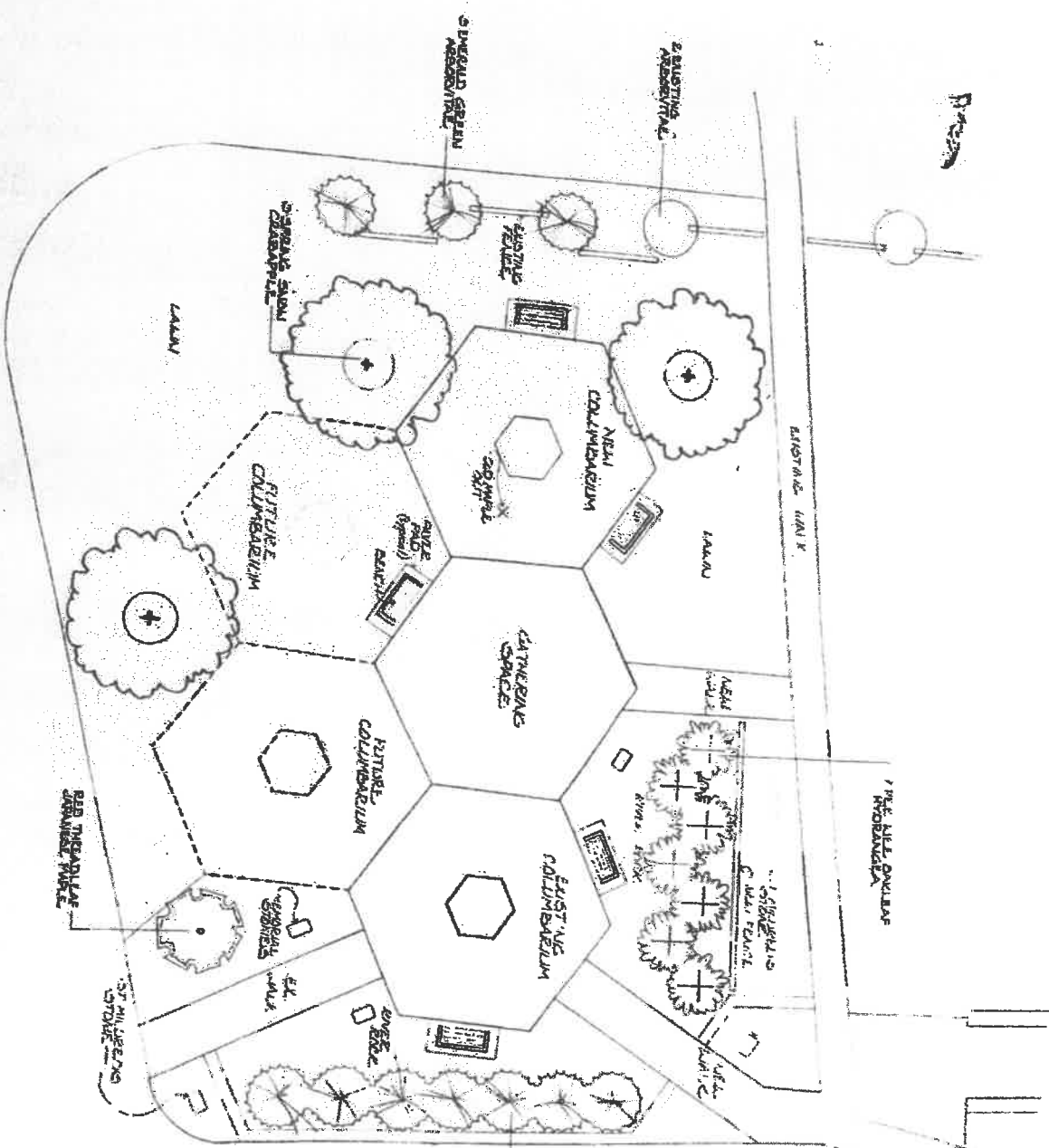
The cost of the project will be covered by money in the columbarium fund currently, with the remainder covered by general funds with the understanding that as money comes in with the sale of niches, that difference will be repaid so that this project is entirely self financed.

We have 16 niches available in our current columbarium. Niches are \$1,250.00 for one person or \$1,500 for two people. Please call the church office if you are interested or want more information.

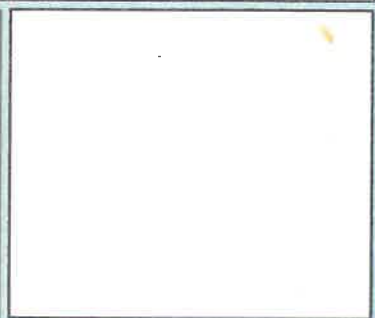
