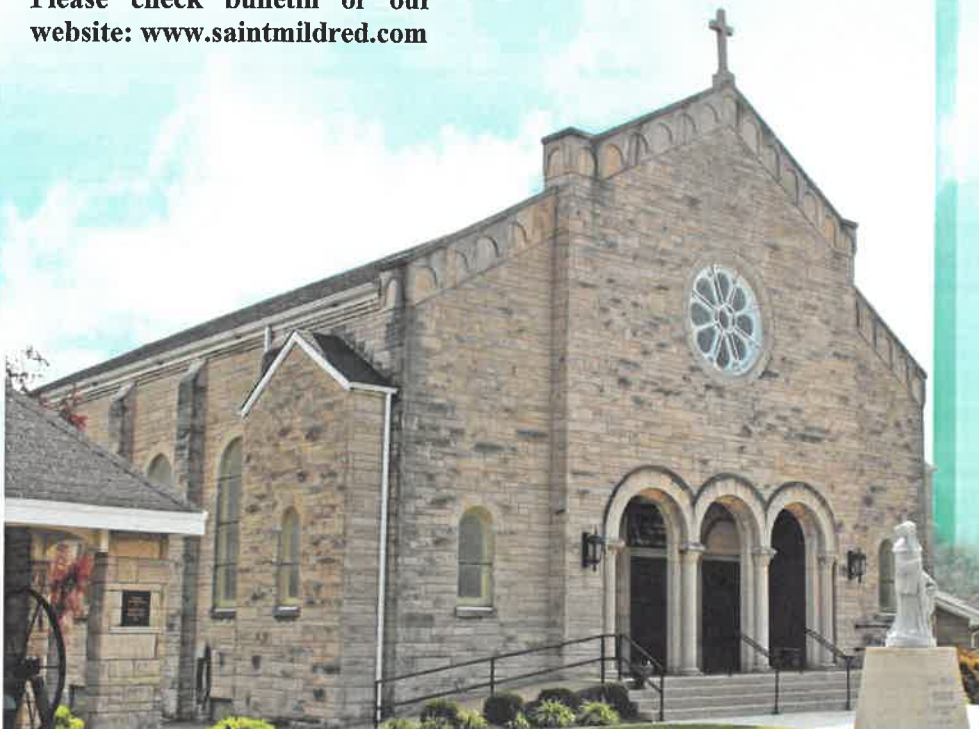

FROM FR. CARLOS:

Dear friends,

This Sunday the Gospel of Matthew brings us an important confession of faith of the disciples by the mouth of Peter. It is not by chance that it takes place in Caesarea Philippi, that is to say in pagan land. Once again Matthew wants to show us the universal character of the mission of Jesus the Christ. The Son of God has come to announce the love of the Father, for all and in a privileged way for the poorest, to all the peoples of the world.

To the first question that Jesus addresses to his disciples. "Who do men say that the Son of Man is? love of God and the practice of justice "Seek the Kingdom, its justice and everything else will be given to you in addition. People who have heard and seen Jesus have understood something important in thinking of him as a prophet.

But this is not enough. The second question is straight and plummets: "Who do you say I am? This is an ever-present question: who is Jesus for us today? Perhaps we would be surprised if we had the courage to answer it.

Este Domingo el evangelio de Mateo nos trae una importante confesión de fe de los discipulos por boca de Pedro. No es por casualidad que ella tiene lugar en Cesarea de Filipo, es decir en tierra pagana. Una vez más Mateo nos quiere indicar el carácter universal de la misión de Jesús el Cristo. El Hijo de Dios ha venido a anunciar el amor del Padre, por todos y en forma privilegiada por los más pobres, a todos los pueblos del mundo.

A la primera pregunta que Jesús dirige a sus discipulos. "¿quién dicen los hombres que es el Hijo del Hombre?, la respuesta es: ellos piensan que eres un proleta, Esa es una buena aproximación. En verdad, Jesús se sitúa en la gran línea profética de Israel, por eso no desliga el amor a Dios y la práctica de la justicia. "Busquen el Reino su justicia y todo lo demás se les dará por añadidura. La gente que ha oído y ha visto a Jesús ha comprendido algo importante en pensar en él como un profeta.

Pero esto no basta. La segunda pregunta es directa y cae en picada: "¿quién dicen ustedes que soy yo? * Este es un interrogante siempre vigente ¿quien es Jesus para nosotros hoy? Tal vez nos sorprenderíamos si tuviéramos el valor de responderla.

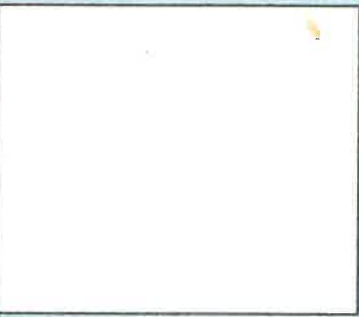
